The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.66 dated 25.08.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 436, 427, 148, 149, 120-B, 188 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") and read with Section 3 and 4 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 and Sections 3 and 4 of Explosive Substances Act, 1908 at Police Station Jaurkian, District Mansa.

Heard.

Learned State counsel has submitted that there is a total loss of Rs.1,25,000/- to public property. However, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted vide order dated 23.10.2017 passed in *CRM-M-34308-2017*, similarly situated persons have been granted the concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that petitioners are in custody since 6th October, 2017 and no injury has been attributed to the police party, they have been

arrayed for the criminal conspiracy, no useful purpose will be served by further detention of the petitioners, the present petition is allowed. Petitioners, namely, Paramjit Singh and Avtar Singh are ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned Area/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

(a) The petitioners shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.

(b) In the event of their absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioners shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel their bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure their presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioners shall have to apply for bail afresh.

(c) They shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
