Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 489, dated 07.06.2017, under Sections 328, 406, 498-A, 509, 34 IPC (Sections 328 and 509 IPC deleted during investigation), registered at Police Station Gurgaon City, District Gurgaon.

It is informed that during the pendency of this petition, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 19.12.2017. The complainant's daughter and her husband i.e. son of the petitioners have filed a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. Part of the settled amount has been handed over to the complainant's daughter. Petitioners undertake to abide by the terms and conditions of the settlement dated 19.12.2017 in letter and in spirit. It is thus prayed that this petition be

allowed.

Learned counsel for the complainant affirms the factum of settlement between the parties and submits that the complainant has no objection in case this petition is allowed subject to the petitioners strictly adhering to the terms and conditions of the settlement.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Hakmu, informs that the petitioners are not reported to be involved in any other criminal case.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioners are likely to abscond or that they are likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above but without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the petitioners, they be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/investigating Officer. Petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so. Petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is clarified that none of the observations made hereinabove shall be construed to be a reflection on the merits of the case. The same are solely confined for the purpose of decision of the present petition.
