The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 24 dated 08.01.2018 under Sections 341, 392, 397 IPC (Section 120-B IPC added later on) and Sections 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 30.01.2018. The investigation is complete as the challan has been presented but only one PW has been examined till date. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and, thus, he may be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual submissions.

It is, thus, apparent that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. In view of the fact that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent, it would be just and appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
