Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.165 dated 13.07.2018 under Sections 323, 379, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 21.08.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Malkiat Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that recovery of one gold chain and ₹8,100/- is required to be effected from the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

So far as recovery of gold chain and ₹8,100/- is concerned, these allegations are required to be seen during the course of trial. Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.08.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
