In the instant petition under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail in case FIR No.2 dated 04.01.2017 under Sections 420/120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

2.) The allegations against the petitioner is that Sandeep Singh, Ajay Chalana and Inderjit Singh have remitted few lakhs of rupees in the petitioner's account. The said money is misappropriated from the complainant and others who have been cheated Sandeep Singh, Ajay Chalana and Inderjit Singh while assuring them that they will get job in Australia. Petitioner is not in a position to apprise this Court as to why Sandeep Singh, Ajay Chalana and Inderjit Singh have deposited the misappropriated money in the petitioner's account. Perusal of the FIR, it is evident that petitioner is also involved in the job racket at abroad.

3.) Learned counsel for the petitioner tried to apprise this Court stating that petitioner is also one of the victim from Sandeep Singh and Inderjit Singh to the extent that petitioner would be provided job at Singapore. In order to complete the petitioner's transaction, Sandeep Singh and Inderjit Singh have managed to deposit the petitioner's amount in the petitioners' account. To that extent, petitioner has not produced any material as to what extent, petitioner has been cheated by Sandeep Singh and Inderjit Singh so also money transaction between the petitioner, Sandeep Singh and Inderjit Singh. Thus, petitioner has not made out a case for anticipatory bail.

4.) Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
