This is the second petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.182 dated 13.09.2017 registered under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Hathoor, Ludhiana.

The petitioner had earlier filed CRM-M No.45047 of 2017, which was listed for the first time on 29.11.2017 and after availing 03 dates, the same was finally dismissed as withdrawn on 15.03.2018 without seeking any permission of the Court to file afresh petition.

The present petition has been filed alleging that the co-accused of the petitioner namely Mandeep Kaur has been granted the concession of regular bail and some of the witnesses have been declared hostile.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioner surrender before the trial Court and prays that the application for bail may be decided expeditiously.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Manohar

Lal, has no serious objection to the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 01 week from today and apply for bail, the trial Court shall dispose of the said application within a period of 02 days, in accordance with law.
