ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.182 dated 13.07.2018, registered under Sections 341, 354-B, 354-D, 506, 201 of IPC at Police Station Chandimandir.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 13.07.2018 and all the sections are bailable except Section 354-B IPC. Counsel further submits that father of the petitioner had made a complaint against the family of the complainant of land grab and they were evicted and they had handed over the papers to the police on the last date of hearing for verification and he had placed on record the order passed by the Assistant Collector. Counsel submits that Karnail Singh is the brother of the father-in-law of the complainant.

Learned State counsel submits that he had recorded the statement of Tempo driver and the allegations against the petitioner are serious. It is stated that the documents were verified by the police but no complaint had been filed against the father-in-law or father of the complainant.

The petitioner has placed on record the copy of the complaint given by father of the petitioner against Karnail Singh. Counsel for the petitioner submits that information was being sought as a wrong date of birth was given and a complaint for illegally occupying Panchayat land had been given and they had placed on record the order passed by the Assistant Collector, Panchkula in January, 2018.

Investigation is over. Trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate with a condition that the petitioner will not tamper with evidence nor get in touch with the complainant or her family.
