Petitioner has gone unrepresented despite last opportunity granted to him on 20.11.2017.

A perusal of the file shows that the instant petition for quashing of summoning order dated 10.07.2013 (Annexure P-2) and complaint dated 30.10.2000 (Annexure P-1), under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is not maintainable, in view of the fact that earlier the petitioner had challenged the aforesaid summoning order by way of criminal revision before the Sessions Court, Rewari. The same was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 23.02.2016 (Annexure P-3). The petitioner has not laid challenge to the order of the revisional Court.

In view of above factual aspect of the case, the instant petition is dismissed, being merit less and not maintainable.

The trial court is directed to proceed with the complaint filed by the respondent No.1 against the petitioner No.1 in accordance with law.
