This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioners in F.I.R. No.195, dated 26.09.2017, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

2. The petitioners were arrested on 26.09.2017.

3. It transpires that investigation has since been completed and challan already submitted.

4. The FIR itself discloses that the victim was attacked with blunt weapons although he suffered from fracture injuries.

4. In the circumstances, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioners, the present petition is allowed and the

petitioners, namely Vijay Kumar and Paras, are directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, concerned.
