Petitioner Ajab Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.91 dated 07.07.2015, registered at Police Station Saha, District Ambala, under Sections 395 and 397 of Indian Penal Code read with Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution case, the FIR was got registered by complainant Sumit Verma alleging therein that on 07.07.2015 at about 5:00 P.M when he was sitting on the chair and one Raju was doing labour work in the shop, in the meantime, one young boy came inside the shop and threatened him and said young boy was having a country made revolver.

The complainant tried to snatch the said revolver, but the young boy who

was having katta pointed at the complainant and at the same time, two more young boys also entered in the shop and took 4-5 kgs. silver and 1½ -2 tolas of gold.

The petitioner has been in custody since 07.11.2015. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
