This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in F.I.R. No.40, dated 20.03.2017, under Sections 379-B, 411 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.1, District Pathankot.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 20.03.2017.

3. It transpires that investigation has since been completed and challan already submitted.

4. In the circumstance, further indefinite detention of the petitioner is not justified.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely Rohit Kumar, is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, concerned which shall however

imposed stringent bail conditions considering that the petitioner is otherwise a resident of outside the State.
