Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.123 dated 02.07.2018 registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 326, 325 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of complainant in court today, is taken on record.

The injury attributed to the petitioner is a kapa blow near the left knee which has been declared as simple.

On the other hand, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has argued that there are total 8 accused who have given beatings to the injured complainant and as many as 9 injuries have been

and they have not been arrested yet.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jagdev Singh, does not dispute the injury attributed to the petitioner. However, he states that investigation in the case is going on and three persons as named by the complainant have been found innocent.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 13.07.2018 and the injury attributed to the petitioner is a kapa blow near the left knee which has been declared simple, petitioner is admitted on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Accordingly, present petition is allowed.
