This is a petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 63 dated 15.11.2016 under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

This Court was pleased to pass the following order on 21.09.2017 :-

“Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that after 12 years of marriage, the deceased wife has committed the suicide. It is also submitted that even though there might be tensions between the parties concerned, however, there is nothing on the record to show that he had instigated her to commit suicide. There is no suicide note left behind. It is also contended that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required, as no recoveries are to be made from him and he is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 12.02.2018.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within a period of one week and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from SI Amrik Singh, confirms the factum of joining investigation by the petitioner.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 21.09.2017 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation; will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
