Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners entered into matrimonial reliance against the wishes of respondent no.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he has submitted a representation dated 17.08.2018 (Annexure P-4). Perusal of representation (Annexure P-4) does not make much of sense.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction

that in case the petitioners submit a fresh representation to the

Superintendent of Police, Mansa, he shall take note of it and act in accordance with law.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent.
