The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in FIR No.184 of 27.08.2017, under Sections 365, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

It is submitted by learned counsel for both the petitioners and the complainant that the matter stands compromised between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court on 19.12.2017.

In view of the facts that the matter stands compromised between the parties, without commenting on the merits of the case, the

petition is allowed and order dated 20.09.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
