By way of filing this petition, the petitioner-Dr. Kulwant Singh seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct fair investigation in FIR No.32 dated 12.3.2011 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot and to submit final report before the Court concerned.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner had got the FIR in question lodged against Sandeep Kaur alleging therein that although she had got a 'Handicap Certificate' issued declaring her to be handicapped to the extent of 45%, but at the same time she also procured a driving license from Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Pathankot declaring herself to be fit. Upon investigation of the matter, the police submitted a cancellation report, wherein the complainant appeared in person and made a statement that he does not agree with the cancellation report and the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Pathankot

upon considering the matter, issued directions to the investigating agency to conduct further investigation in the matter, vide order dated 3.7.2017.

The learned counsel has submitted that despite the fact that the FIR in question was lodged way back in the year 2011 and the aforesaid order for conducting further investigation was passed in July 2017, the police has not done the needful so as to take the case to a logical conclusion.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-14) dated 12.6.2018, moved by the petitioner, and to ensure that the matter is got investigated expeditiously in accordance with law and after conclusion of the further investigation as ordered vide order dated 3.7.2017, final report is submitted in the matter at the earliest preferably within a period of two months from today. A copy of this order alongwith representation (Annexure P-14) dated 12.6.2018 be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
