By this petition, quashing of FIR No. 235 dated 11.08.2014 is sought, registered against the petitioner at Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioner (accused) and respondent no. 2, i.e. the complainant.

Vide an order of this Court dated 30.01.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court to get their statements recorded, in terms of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh, has been sent to this Court, in which it is stated that the complainant-respondent no. 2 (Harjivan Kaur Grewal) and the accused-petitioner (Shekhar Chander), have both suffered statements to the effect that the matter has been compromised without any fear, or pressure on either of them.

Copies of the statements of both, the petitioner (accused) and respondent no. 2 (complainant), have also been annexed with the report.

Learned counsel for the U.T., Chandigarh, on instructions from HC Yashpal Singh, submits that there is no other criminal case seen to be registered against the petitioner.

In view of the above, in the opinion of this Court, it would be pointless to continue with criminal proceedings, the parties having fully compromised the matter of their own free will, the alleged offence arising out of an alleged misuser of cheques.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 235 dated 11.08.2014, registered against the petitioner at Police Station Sector-17, Chandigarh, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
