Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.13 dated 08.02.2017 under Section 307 read with Section 34 IPC as well as Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station City-2 Malerkotla, District Sangrur.
