Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No. 29 dated 21.02.2018 under Sections 420, 273, 468, 120-B of IPC and Section 65 of copy of Right Act & Sections 7, 10, 55 of Essential Commodities Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Brara, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relied upon the bail granted to the co-accused of the petitioner. It is further contended that the petitioner is in custody since 22.02.2018. Challan has already been filed. The trial is likely to take long time and the petitioner is not required for any investigation purposes.

On the other hand, learned State counsel does not dispute the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted bail by this Court.

In view of the above submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending

trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the
Trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
