Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.688 dated 05.10.2016 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 23.08.2018: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, by impersonation and preparing a forged GPA, the land of Dr. Krishan Kumar Madan, who is presently residing abroad, has been sold. It is further submitted that beneficiary of the alleged sale deed Veena as well as the person, who impersonated himself as Dr. Krishan Kumar Madan i.e. co-accused Mewa Lal Verma, were arrested and they have been granted the concession of regular bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that

the anticipatory bail application of the petitioner has been dismissed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad on the premise that it is yet to be established as to who impersonated in place of Dr. Krishan Kumar Madan. It is also submitted that the petitioner is a senior citizen and he is not a signatory of the GPA or sale deed.

Notice of motion for 26.10.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mukesh Giri, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.08.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
