The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in complaint case No. 04 of 2016 dated 02.02.2016 pending in the Court of JMIC Moonak wherein the petitioner was summoned under Sections 323, 509 of the Indian Penal Code and 3/4 of SC/ST Act, 1989.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance to the order dated 21.08.2018, the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the trial Court and is facing the proceedings there.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on the ground that a complaint has already

been filed on 01.10.2018 at Police Station Moonak alleging harassment at the hands of the petitioner and argues that the bail should not be confirmed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that the matter has already been inquired into and a complaint has already been filed.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the trial Court and furnished bail bonds and surety bonds, no further orders are called for and the interim bail allowed to him is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of .
