This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 2 dated 11.01.2018, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506, 307 of the IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Khizrabad, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in judicial custody since 05.06.2018 and during the pendency of trial, the matter stands compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Shamsheer Singh, submits that the police has no information about any compromise between the parties.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that matter has been compromised between the parties being a version and cross-version

case and the complainant has no objection in case the petitioner is released on bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the custody period of the petitioner and also in view of the fact that learned counsel for the complainant has stated at par that the matter stands compromised being a version and cross-version case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
