Learned counsel for respondent No.2 – complainant states that the dispute has in fact been resolved amicably between the parties and the complainant has no objection, if the present petition is accepted.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, Police Station Dasuya states that since the petitioner has joined the investigation and the dispute has been resolved, the petitioner is not required by the local police in connection with further investigation.

Therefore, the petition is accepted and it is directed that in the event of his arrest in this case, the petitioner be released on bail, subject to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer on following terms and conditions:

- 1) that he shall make himself available for

interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

- 2) that he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- 3) that he shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court; and
- 4) he shall surrender his passport before the Investigating Officer if he has got one otherwise to furnish affidavit in that regard.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
