Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass the petitioners or call them in police station without following the proper procedure.

Reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police (Gill-Rural), Ludhiana has already been filed and as per this reply, petitioner No.1 is wife of Gaurav Bajaj, petitioners No.2 & 3 are brothers-in-law and petitioner No.4 is mother-in-law of said Gaurav Bajaj. The police, during the investigation of a murder case, has issued summons under Section 160 Cr.P.C. to said Gaurav Bajaj, but he was not traceable and in that process, the police has visited the house of Gaurav Bajaj. It is further stated that neither any illegal demand is made from the petitioners nor they are wanted by the police.
