The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate direction to the respondents to provide adequate security to the petitioners for protection of their life and liberty.

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court reply by way of affidavit of Lakhvir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Guru Harashai, District Ferozepur on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 was filed and paragraph No.1 of preliminary submissions inter alia reads as under:

“ There is no apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioners as alleged by them in the present petition. Petitioners are Councilors of Municipal Committee, Guru Harsahai and meeting of the Municipal Council, Guruharsahai are being held every month without any interruption.”

Perusal of the same reveals that there is no apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioners. Still further the affidavit on merits Para 1(iii) says that the petitioners have not made any application regarding any threat to their life before the police and as on today there is no apprehension of threat to their life.

In view of the submission made in the affidavit of respondent there is no ground for this Court to issue further direction in the matter.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed off.

However, liberty is granted that in case the petitioners apprehends any threat to their life and liberty in future, they are at liberty to approach this Court again.
