Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have already joined investigation which fact was confirmed by the counsel for the State on 05.02.2018 when the case was taken up for hearing.

Counsel for the State today also, on instructions from ASI Mohd. Harun, Police Station Surajkund, Faridabad, submits that recoveries have been effected from the petitioners and, therefore, they are no more required for the purpose of investigation as of now.

Counsel for the complainant, on the other hand, vehemently argues that apart from the present case, there are two other cases against them and they are habitual offenders. Whatever be the position, in the present case since the petitioners have joined investigation and they are no more required for investigation for the present, the present petition is allowed.

Order dated 21.09.2017 is made absolute.

The petitioners shall, however, continue joining investigation as and when required.
