Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has filed reply on behalf of respondent No.3, which is taken on record.

After hearing counsel for the two sides, as per stand of the respondents, elder son of the petitioner who was then studying in BBA in S.D.College, Sector 32, Chandigarh, as per the knowledge gathered by them was an NRI from Canada and has left on his own which is also the case of the petitioner well illuminated from Page-77 of this petition. Mr. J.S.Toor, APP, UT, Chandigarh, on instructions from SI Sukhwinder Singh, Police Station, Sector-26, Chandigarh submits that there is no suspicious angle to this missing of his own by a grown up person regarding which even the petitioner has not lodged any missing report till date. However, keeping in view these circumstances no cause for the petitioner to file instant petition is made out. However, in the interest of justice official respondents are

directed to ensure due protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioner as there is admittedly a property dispute between the landlord and tenant who also happens to be inter-related to each other.

The present petition stands disposed off as such.
