This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.66 dated 5.2.2015 under sections 147, 149, 323, 452, 379, 427, 506 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Sector 5, Gurgaon, District Gurgaon.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner as also her other family members have been falsely implicated at the instance of husband of co-accused Anjali (real sister of the present petitioner) and who is having illicit relations with the complainant. Further submitted that perusal of the FIR would reveal that the main allegations are against co-accused Anjali and who has already been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail in the light of order dated 2.5.2016 passed by this Court in CRM-M-43680-2015 (Annexure P-3).

It has also gone uncontroverted that in the light of notice of motion order dated 25.9.2017 passed by this Court petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from H.C Kiranpal concedes to this fact.

Under such circumstances, custodial interrogation of the petitioner would not be warranted. Accordingly, present petition is allowed. Order dated 25.9.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
