Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.72 dated 14.03.2013 registered under Sections 406/420 IPC at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 10.06.2018 (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 24.08.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, a report dated 26.11.2018 has been received from learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur, wherein it has been intimated that the parties have not appeared before the learned Magistrate for recording their statements in support of compromise

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in FIR No.72 (supra), the petitioner was declared Proclaimed Officer vide order dated 21.04.2014 and the said order has been challenged by the petitioner in a separate petition i.e. CRM-M-14245-2016 titled as “Sukhwinder Singh @ Sukhi Versus State of Punjab.”

Heard.

In view of the pending PO proceedings, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage, however, with liberty to file a fresh one in case the PO proceedings are set aside.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
