Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.367 dated 28.07.2018, registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar, under Sections 323, 324, 377, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that allegation against the present petitioner is regarding giving simple injury with sharp edged weapon. As

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per the MLR, the said injury is superficial one. The main allegation regarding inserting a stick in the anus of the complainant is against other persons and qua that, learned State counsel has brought into notice of this Court that no external injury was found.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 24.08.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. The petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 24.08.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
