JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.6 and 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein contends that respondent No.6 is wife of the petitioner herein whereas, respondent No.7 is the father-in-law, who is a drunkard person and is in the habit of moving false complaint against petitioner and his family members and it is on this account that they have been harassed. It is also contended that the matter has been compromised on several occasions inter se between the parties, however, despite the compromise and settlement arrived at between them,

private respondents herein continued to harass the petitioner herein.

Reply by way of affidavit of Satyapal, HPS, DSP Rewari has been filed by the respondent-State, in which it is submitted that there is a matrimonial discord between the petitioner and his wife and in fact, respondent No.6-wife herself has moved the applications alleging harassment at the hands of the petitioner herein. There are even complaints pending against the petitioner in the Women Police Station where, the matter had been compromised and the petitioner herein was to take respondent No.6-wife along with him, however, she was again subjected to cruelty and thrown out of her matrimonial home.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the reply filed, no ground is made out to interfere with the matter.

Disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
