In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.250 dated 07.05.2018, under Sections 379-A IPC registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is not involved in any other case therefore, he is entitled for regular bail.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions of SI Balbir Singh submitted that petitioner is not involved in any other case. Challan has been filed.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners, especially having regard to the fact that petitioner is not

involved in any other case and challan has already been presented in the trial court and disposal of the trial will take sufficient time, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

6. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Naresh @ Rajat is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

7. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.

8. Petition stands allowed.
