1. In the present petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No. 152 dated 06.06.2018, under Sections 324, 323, 326, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that alleged incident relating to altercation between petitioner and others was on 26.05.2018, whereas FIR has been registered on 06.06.2018 for the offences under Sections 326/324/323/34 IPC.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, submitted that petitioner is in custody from 12.06.2018 and challan has been presented. Petitioner is not involved in any other case.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. Having regard to the factual aspects and trial Court would take

some time, petitioner is entitled for regular bail, therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed.

Petitioner – Kashmir Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate / Duty Magistrate concerned with the following condition:-

- (i) Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.
