The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.70 dated 16.5.2018, under Sections 452, 341, 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC, Police Station Payal, Ludhiana.

The main ground canvassed in the petition is that a compromise has been effected amongst the parties.

The aforesaid position is not disputed by the learned State counsel who upon instructions from ASI Darshan Lal and has affirmed the aforesaid fact. It has also been informed that the petitioners have since joined the investigation and are no longer required for any further investigation.

In view of the aforesaid position, in my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. The petition is as such accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 24.8.2018 are made absolute subject to the

condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed and would fully cooperate with the investigation.
