Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for seeking bail pending trial for the petitioner in FIR No. 357 dated 1.9.2017, under Sections 307/34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no evidence against the petitioner. Even the injured witnesses have not supported the prosecution case. The petitioner is in custody since 3.9.2017 and he is not required for any investigation purposes. Trial is likely to take long time. Therefore, the petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Joginder Singh, does not dispute the fact that the injured witnesses have not fully supported the case of the prosecution.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of

the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
