The present petition filed under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the family members of petitioner No.1 and his relatives and friends i.e. respondents No.4 to 7, since the petitioners have married each other against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7.

Status report by way of affidavit of Gurdev Singh Dhaliwal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), Patiala filed by learned State counsel is taken on record. It transpires that petitioners have already suffered a statement that they had solemnized marriage with each other without the consent of their parents, now they both are living together peacefully and they do not apprehend any threat from any one and they do not require any police protection.

In this view of the matter, the present petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

However, in case any of the petitioners apprehend any threat to their limb, life and liberty in future, they may approach to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala and in that eventuality, be provided protection as prayed for.
