1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner, prayer has been made to call for a report from respondent No.3 as in spite of representations given to police, no action has been taken against the accused persons and his life and liberty is still in danger at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, is directed to decide representation dated 11.06.2018 (Annexure P-2), moved by the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, is directed to look into the matter and decide representation dated 11.06.2018 (Annexure P-2), moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
