The present petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 325 dated 25.12.2017, registered under Sections 380, 457 IPC at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

The FIR states that when the complainant was out of station, his house was burgled by unknown thieves and some jewellery and cash were stolen. Pursuant to the FIR, the petitioners have been named as an accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR was against unknown people and that the petitioners are ready to join investigation.

The contention is wholly misconceived. Anybody can never be named in a case of theft. The police investigation is underway and recovery is yet to be effected. I see no reason to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. The petition is dismissed.
