The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 369 dated 29.10.2017 under Sections 452, 323, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Jalandhar (Rural), District Jalandhar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Mr. B.S. Jaswal, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 & 3 and has filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.

Vide order dated 27.08.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Rani and Mandeep Kaur have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant and Mandeep Kaur have no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 369 dated 29.10.2017 under Sections 452, 323, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Jalandhar (Rural), District Jalandhar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
