Vakalatnama on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 filed in Court today is taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.457 dated 10.12.2013 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 452, 365, 427 and 511 IPC at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 06.07.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 27.08.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 04.09.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Fatehabad, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.1202, dated 05.09.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Fatehabad, vide letter No.7621, dated

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According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Fatehabad, is satisfied that parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without any pressure or coercion. No accused has been declared proclaimed offender.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Fatehabad, dated 05.09.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid FIR No.457 dated 10.12.2013 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana High Court, ₹1,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and ₹5,000/- with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Legal Services Committee within one week from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.

Disposed of accordingly.
