Learned Senior counsel representing the respondents has contended that as the challan in this case has been filed in the Court, the petition has become infructuous. Whereas learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that in the petition, he has prayed for issuance of direction to the official respondents to investigate the matter properly as well as to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and his family members.

Under the circumstances, since challan has been filed in the Court of competent jurisdiction, the prayer of the petitioners for issuance of direction to official respondents to investigate the matter properly has obviously become infructuous. As regards the remaining part of the prayer, a direction is issued to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib - respondent No.4 to ensure that lives and liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardized at hands of respondents

No.6 to 11 and they are not put to any harassment at hands of private respondents.
Though in case any complaint is received against the petitioners that may be
looked into and necessary action taken in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
