issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take legal action against
respondent No.4-M/s Cholamandlam Investment and Finance Company
Limited, who is trying/making an attempt to forcible take away the vehicle

(Truck bearing registration No.RJ131G0107) of the petitioner with the help of recovery agents and henchmen while it was running on road despite the fact that the petitioner has paid the entire loan amount.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 has fairly stated that the matter has been settled between the parties and the petitioner has paid the outstanding amount to respondent No.4.

In view of above, present petition is rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.

Along with the petition, the petitioner has also filed CRM-28748-2018 under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent No.4-M/s Cholamandlam Investment and Finance Company Limited, to give No Objection Certificate to the petitioner with regard to the loan account No.XVFPCGH0001002474, as the petitioner has paid the entire loan amount.

Since learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.4 has categorically stated that outstanding loan amount has been paid to respondent No.4 by the petitioner, it shall be incumbent upon respondent No.4 to issue No Objection Certificate to the petitioner.

CRM-28748-2018 also stands disposed of.
