The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction for the representation dated 20.02.2018 to be decided expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if respondent No.1 and 2 be directed to look into the representation dated 20.02.2018 (Annexure P-1) and take action in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Seena Mand, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioners within a period of two months, on receipt of

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 20.02.2018 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
