This petition has been filed in Court for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 392 dated 22.06.2017, under Sections 147,302,323,452 read with Section 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Rohtak, Distrcit Rohtak.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the co-accused have been acquitted by the judgment dated 01.12.2017, a photocopy of which has been produced in Court and has been perused by me. He further, submits that a compromise has been reached with the complainant. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the complainant.

3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is allowed;

petitioner-Smt. Namita Jain, is ordered to be released on anticipatory bail in case of her arrest in the aforementioned FIR subject to her compliance of conditions, enshrined under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.. She shall appear before the Investigating Officer on 26.02.2018 at 10:00 a.m. and will continue to appear as and when required by the Investigating Agency. Upon filing of challan, the petitioner will seek regular bail before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate.
