This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a Criminal Complaint COMA/000053 of 07.11.2014, File No. COMA/0001495/2014 titled as Satnam Kaur Vs. Ajit Singh & others, under Section 3(1)(ii), 3(1)(x) and 3(1)(xxiv) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 pending in the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel representing the petitioners has furnished for perusal of this Court during the course of hearing a certified copy of order dated 07.11.2017 and which reveals that the petitioners have duly appeared before the trial Court and were admitted on bail on furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds for a sum of Rs.1 lakh each with one surety in the like amount.

Certified copy of order dated 07.11.2017 is taken on record as mark 'A'.

The contention raised by counsel representing the petitioners that complainant/respondent No.2, Satnam Kaur had a previous land dispute with the petitioners has not been rebutted by counsel representing the complainant.

Contention raised by counsel that the allegations contained in the complaint for commission of offence under the SC/ST Act are motivated, cannot be said to be without substance.

Petitioners having already joined trial proceedings, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted.

Order dated 25.09.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute.
