By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents to protect his life and liberty and also of other members of his family.

It is averred in the petition that the petitioner had been married to Guggi daughter of respondent No.4, about 6 years back. Subsequently, succumbing to the pressure of private respondents, he started residing with his in-laws as '*Ghar Jawai*' and also took along with him his 25 sheep, 2 buffaloes and gold articles and an amount of ₹2 lacs. It is alleged that subsequently he was thrown out of the house of his in-laws while his sheep, buffaloes and gold articles were retained by them. The petitioner has alleged that he was badly beaten up and that he apprehends threat to his life and liberty.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to decide the representation (Annexure P-1) expeditiously. In case the apprehension of the petitioner is found to be well founded, necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-1) be sent to respondent No.2 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
