In the instant petition petitioner has sought for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to take action in accordance with law on the representation dated 30.03.2018 (Annexure P-4) and further to protect life, liberty and property of the petitioner from the respondents No.4 to 10.

Perusal of Annexure P4 it is evident that very bald and vague allegations have been made by the petitioner against contesting respondents so also protection to the petitioner and his family members. In the absence of specific allegations with dates and events, representation could not be entertained by the competent authority. In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioner has not made out a case. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach concerned police officer with concrete material if any available with him.
