This is a petition under section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.45, dated 01.04.2017, under sections 307, 452, 323 and 324 IPC, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 22.09.2017, report dated 07.10.2017 of the Additional District & Sessions Judge, Faridkot, has been received. According to the said report, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been reached between the parties out of their own free will and without any threat or coercion.

3. In view of the law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in **Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2014(2) R.C.R.(Criminal) 482** and the fact that the parties are residents of the same village and in order to ensure that peace is restored between them, instant petition is allowed and FIR No.45, dated 01.04.2017, under sections 307, 452, 323 and 324 IPC, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot, alongwith all consequent proceedings having arisen therefrom, is hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
