This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 342, 395, 397 IPC (offence under sections 412, 458, 120-B IPC subsequently added) at Police Station Dabwali Sadar, District Sirsa, vide FIR No.317 dated 26.11.2017.

Petitioner is incarcerated since 2.12.2017. Allegation against him is that he purchased the stolen bags and destroyed the gunny bags. Main accused are in custody. However, investigation is in progress. Keeping in view nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner and period of incarceration, this court feels that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.
