Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.84 dated 08.04.2018 registered under Sections 452, 323, 316, 506, 34 of IPC at Police Station Nakodar Sadar, Police District Jalandhar Rural, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 24.08.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

However, a report dated 01.10.2018 has been received from learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar to the effect that the

statements could not be recorded as the parties did not appear before the court.

In view of above when the parties have not come forward to get their statements recorded in support of the compromise and the present petition is filed for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise, this Court finds that the compromise is very much in doubt.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.

However, in case the petitioners arrive at a genuine compromise, they are at liberty to file a fresh petition.
